# CHATEAU Thénac



## 1621 - CHÂTEAU THÉNAC 2020

"A Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon blend from Bergerac with a lovely landscape image label by artist Kathryn Maple. Robust, powerful aromas of hickory, gorse, mandarin slices and raspberries. A happy, lively, balanced and sprightly juice in the mouth. Quite the cascade of fresh flavours. Attack a beefy array of cocoa and drop licorice, while the mid palate includes marshmallows and cherries and the finish has a hit of chocolate and pine. Pair with a provolone and Bayon ham croque monsieur or After Eight mints"

Le nom de cette cuvée spéciale, issue de deux parcelles, rappelle que sur ce domaine d'origine monastique, on faisait déjà du vin il y a quatre siècles; Après une macération de 6 semaines, le vin a séjourné 18 mois en barrique puis 6 mois en cuve. Dans le verre, il se montre très sombre, presque opaque, et dévoile un nez précis et complexe, beurré, légèrement mentholé et réglissé. Rond et gourmand en attaque, il monte en puissance, soutenu par une trame de tanins épices. La longue finale, encore teinté d'amertume, signe un réel potentiel."

"Full and deep aromas of red fruit, including strawberries, and florals that include roses. In the mouth, a light, elegant, juicy river of red fruit flavours, and some mocha and mint on the finish. Soft tannins, quiet acidity. Not complex, but satisfying. Well made, well balanced. Pair with oxtail soup or beef stew. Still young."

"This shows lots of structure and richness with blackcurrant, dark chocolate and some hazelnut. It's full-bodied and chewy with lots of fruit and structure. Flavourful finish. Needs time to soften the rough edges. Drink after 2024."

## CHÂTEAU THÉNAC 2018

"Les 4 cépages rouges de l'appellation contribuent à l'harmonie de cette cuvée élevée 12 mois en barrique, une goutte de malbec venant compléter le merlot majoritaire (66%) et les deux cabernets. Si le fût apporte ses touches épicées et grillées, il laisse toute sa place au raisin, qui s'épanouit sur des notes de fruits noirs, mûre et cassis en tête. Ce fruité très présent se confirme dans une bouche harmonieuse et longue, à laquelle le merlot apporte sa rondeur et les cabernets leur structure tannique et leur mâche."

Assertive, citric, exuberant. Consider pairing with marinated raw tuna."

## CHÂTEAU THÉNAC 2018

"Pale and light gold in colour. The nose is complex with notes of pineapple, mandarin orange and hint of white flowers: honeysuckle and orange blossom. The palate is opulent and luxurious but the sweetness is perfectly enhanced by a nice acidity and a long finish. A wine to drink now or to keep for several years, it will age beautifully. Ideally matched with traditional dishes such as Foie Gras, blue cheeses or with dessert such Crème Brûlée or poached pears."

"Ce pur sémillon de haute volée revêt une magnifique robe jaune vif aux reflets verts. Fruits mûrs et fruits confits, fleur d'acacia et vanille; le nez est expressif et délicat.
